A book you have on your ereader but have not read yet

A book about the Victorian age (fiction or nonfiction)—

Publishing date does not matter.

Locked room/trapped on an island mystery

Book with a three word title

A book with a dog (or cat) on the cover

A debut novel

A Christmas book

Read a genre hybrid book

Read a novel with recipes, then make one of the recipes listed in the book

Read a travelogue

Read a book that has been on the top 10 of the New York Times Best Sellers' list for 5 weeks or more in 2020—fiction or nonfiction.

Read a book with an immortal character

Read a book with a librarian as a main character

Biography/Memoir written by a person of color

Read a book that falls under the theme "back to school" (school setting, features a student, etc)

Read a collection of essays

Read a book from a series with 20 or more titles in it

Read a book with an animal as the main character

Read a book with one or more of the following key words in the title (synonyms & suffixes allowed)—Dear, Ink, Mercy, Fly, Lost, Never, Match, True

Read a book about the environment or an environmental issue (fiction or nonfiction)

A nonfiction book that explores mental health

A book recommended by a library staff member

A refugee story (fiction or nonfiction)

A book about siblings (fiction or nonfiction)

Read an epic saga

Rules:

- Complete 15 of the 25 challenges within 2021.
- You may count one book for multiple challenges, but the book must have been read in 2021.
- Write the title of the book on the line next to the challenge you are completing.
- Return completed sheet to the Library to be entered in to a drawing.
- December 31, 2021 is the last day to return challenge sheet.
